
Ross' Piece

Although the accounts for FY11/12 have yet to be prepared, it seems that excluding our "Friends" \$60,000 contribution, donations last financial year were 20% down on 10/11. I guess the politicians' scare-mongering have contributed to this. Sadly this will mean that the wells construction programme for 2013, will be significantly reduced.

As part of our efforts in improving transparency, at the suggestion of one of our supporters, we have put on the website a complete list of all wells built since 2002 up to and including 2011. It can be found under the "FAQ" section. Location co-ordinates will be added mid-September.

A Sad Period for All Ethiopians



On 16 August, The Patriarch of the Ethiopian Orthodox Church, Abune Paulos, passed away in Addis Ababa. He had been head of the church since 1992. About half of Ethiopians follow the Orthodox Church, which separated from the Coptic Orthodox Church in 1959. Most other Ethiopians are either Protestant or Muslim.

Just 4 days later, Ato Meles Zenawi died in a Belgian hospital at the age of 57. He was Prime Minister since the overthrow of the Derg [Mengistu's communist regime] in 1991. Mr. Meles is credited with spearheading economic development in Ethiopia. He was austere and hardworking, with a discipline forged from years spent in the guerrilla movement that fought against the communists.

One of our trustees, Mr. Graham Romanes, had met Mr. Meles on several occasions, including during the war when Graham himself was in the sector held by the rebels when he worked for Community Aid Abroad (now Oxfam Australia).

The deputy prime minister, Mr Hailemariam Desalegn, becomes prime minister until the next elections, due in 2015. It is expected that Mr. Meles' aim of lifting its citizens out of abject poverty will be maintained by the new PM.

Wells' Construction Progress



We have received REST's [our Ethiopian Programme Implementation Partner] Interim Report for this year's construction progress. Of the 96 wells and bores commenced, on average they are 36% complete. They and the 28 yet to be started, are scheduled for completion during December 2012.

Tax Deductible Receipts These are issued late in the month following the calendar month in which donations are received. Over 95% of those donations go to the wells programme, the rest being for newsletters and institutional fees. Due to Diana's [from Melbourne] illness, receipting is now being done by Kate from Pt Macquarie. Kate is using a system designed by Dave of Melbourne to simplify the process. Thanks Kate and Dave. We received over 40 offers of help when the SOS was sent out! Thanks so much for that. We wish Diana good health and thank her for her invaluable help.
