Our Friend will again match donations in 2011/12, \$1 for \$1 up to \$60,000. Donate generously now.



Safe water brings all-round impact

Mereseit G/Medhin is a 36 years old married woman living in Handego village, 93 km north of Mekelle, the Tigrayan capital. She is a mother of eight children of whom six are students at different levels

She recalls her life before the construction of the well, saying (in her own translated words), *"I used to travel more than 3 hours to collect unsafe water from a river that was at the same time consumed by our animals"* W/ro Mereseit and the community in general had used the river as a primary source of water for drinking for generations until *WellWishers* funded the construction of a Hand Dug Well.

She said that the availability of the well has had beneficial impact on her and her family's life. She said, *"This time, I fetch clean water travelling no longer than 10 minutes of walk from my home and focus on taking care of my family and involved in other activities such as soil and water conservation activities of the village."*

She also added that the well in her village has positively impacted on the health status of her family. *"Before, it was common to frequently observe various intestinal infections, especially our children were very much vulnerable. But since the construction of this well, our health is protected from such infections."*

Access to water benefits children

Agona is a village located in Saesie Taseda Emba Woreda. Like in most villages in the area, a large portion of the community used to travel long distances down to a river and this situation was directly affecting women and children who took responsibility of most household tasks.

Yenes Tekley, 18, is a 10th grade student living in Agona. She lives with her family including her three sisters and three brothers. She said she used to spend around 2 hours of long tedious travel daily, to collect water from the river resulting in her not regularly attending class.

The present situation is different from the past thanks to the *WellWishers* funded Water Supply Development Project intervention in that area. She said (in her own words), *"Since this well has been constructed, we are getting quality water without walking long distances and hence regularly attending class. The availability of the well has greatly helped me to attend my educational properly."*

Yenes added that the well has also benefited her younger brothers and sisters in allowing them to attend school. She also thanked those who particularly helped the women and children, in solving the community's major problem.
